
South Asian computing expenditure accounts for **8.4%** of total student computing expenditure, which is significant as Asians only account for 4% of the total UK population.

India is the second largest exporter of students into the UK

The number of higher education students from India rose by **24%** between 2005/06 and 2006/07.

The number of students from Pakistan had increased by **17%** between 2005/06 and 2006/07 Source - HESA





The total student demand for international student places will grow from **2.1 million** in 2003 to **5.8 million** in 2020.

Based on 2003 estimates, international education is worth **£10billion** p.a. to the UK economy
